NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
ON DRAFT GENERIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT AND  
DRAFT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Village Board of the Village of New Square, New York, has accepted as adequate for the purpose of public review a Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (“DGEIS”) regarding the draft Comprehensive Plan and subsequent Code amendments, and that the Village Board will conduct a public hearing at the Village Hall, on September 25, 2019, at 6 P.M. to receive public comment on the DGEIS, draft Comprehensive Plan and Proposed Zoning amendments. This is a Type I action pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”). The draft Comprehensive Plan identifies goals and objectives, principles, guidelines, and means to provide for, guide, and regulate the immediate and long-range enhancement, growth, and development of the Village. The Board will consider all oral and written comment on potential environmental impacts and other issues that should be addressed by the Board in a Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement (“FGEIS”) for the proposed action, and on all issues concerning the draft Comprehensive Plan. Written comments on the DGEIS will be received until ten (10) days after the close of the public hearing.

A complete copy of the draft Comprehensive Plan/DGEIS is available for inspection at the Village Clerk's Office at the Village Hall and at the Finkelstein Memorial Library, located at 24 Chestnut St., Spring Valley, NY 10977, during normal business hours.

The Village of New Square will make every effort to assure that the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. Anyone requiring special assistance and/or reasonable accommodations should contact the Village Clerk.
